1. Introduction

This Statistical Bulletin was compiled by the Armstat in collaboration with the Danish and Lithuanian Statistical services and experts from the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).

The information sources of the bulletin include:

1. Information about the results of economic activities of operating legal entities and individual entrepreneurs (economic entities) covered by the statistical monitoring of the Armstat.
2. Information about the results of activities of economic entries provided by the RA State Revenue Committee to the Armstat.

2. Methodological Overview

As a basis for the development of the present bulletin have served the Eurostat and OECD methodology on SME statistics.

1. SME statistics is maintained on an annual basis based on the available annual outcomes of the previous year.
2. The framework of SMEs includes the following sectors of non-financial business economy of the Statistical classification of economic activities in the European Community (NACE Rev.2): B - Mining and quarrying, C - Manufacturing industry, D - Supply of electricity, gas, steam and conditioned air, E - water supply, sewerage, waste management and recycling F - construction G - wholesale and retail trade, car and motorcycle repair H - shipping and storage, I - housing and public catering, J - information and communications, L - activities related to real estate, M - professional, scientific and technical activity, N - administrative and subsidiary activities as well as S95 - Repair of computers and personal and household goods under the section S (Other services activities).
3. Differentiation of SME entities is made on the institutional level on the basis of main type of economic activities.
4. Volume of goods produced and services delivered by SME entities (profit) does not include the value added tax and the excise tax.
5. The main type of economic activity is determined by the maximum added value generated by specific types of economic activities.
6. Differentiation of SME entities is made based on their size defined exclusively by the average annual number of employees with a breakdown to the following groups:

Micro	Up to 9
Including <i>those having 0 wage-earner</i>	0
Small	10-49
Medium-Sized	50-249

7. The number of employees includes the wage-earners working on the basis of an open-ended or fixed-term employment contract.
8. The EU and OECD international data set consider the enterprises (institutional units) as key elements of SME demography maintenance. These are entities independent in their financial and investment decisions that have an authority and responsibility for allocation of resources in the production of goods and delivery of services and can implement one or more types of economic activities in one or more locations.
9. The SME business demography (birth death (termination of activities liquidation) survival (duration)) is carried out according to the following groups defined by the number of employees:
 - 1) Micro enterprises
Including:
 - *those with 0 wage-earners (employees).*
 - *with 1-4 wage-earners (employees)*
 - *5-9 wage-earners (employees)*
 - 2) economic entities with 10-19 wage-earners (employees).
 - 3) economic entities with 20 or more wage-earners (employees).

Figure 1. Structure of number of economic entities by NACE Rev.2 sections, 2023

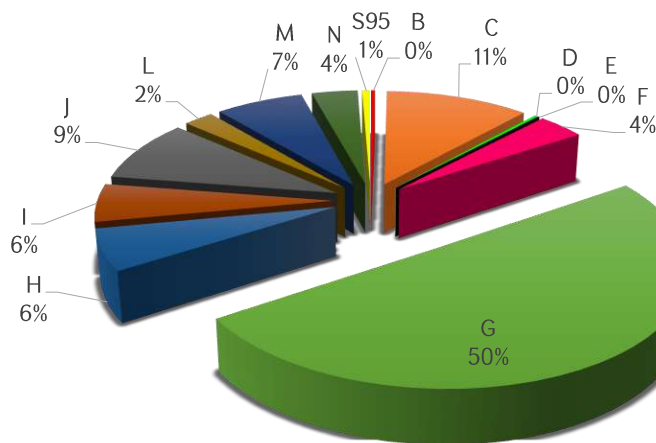


Figure 2. Structure of number of economic entities by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

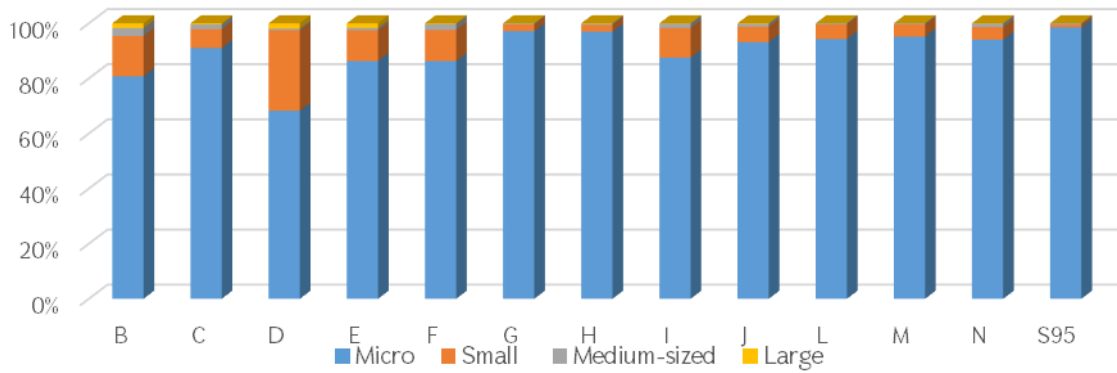


Figure 3. Structure of number of economic entities by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city, 2023

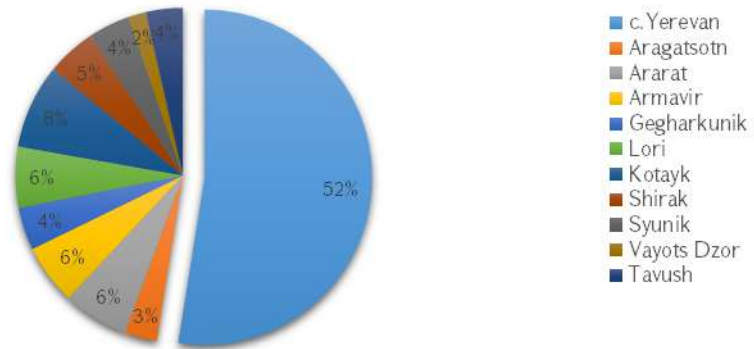
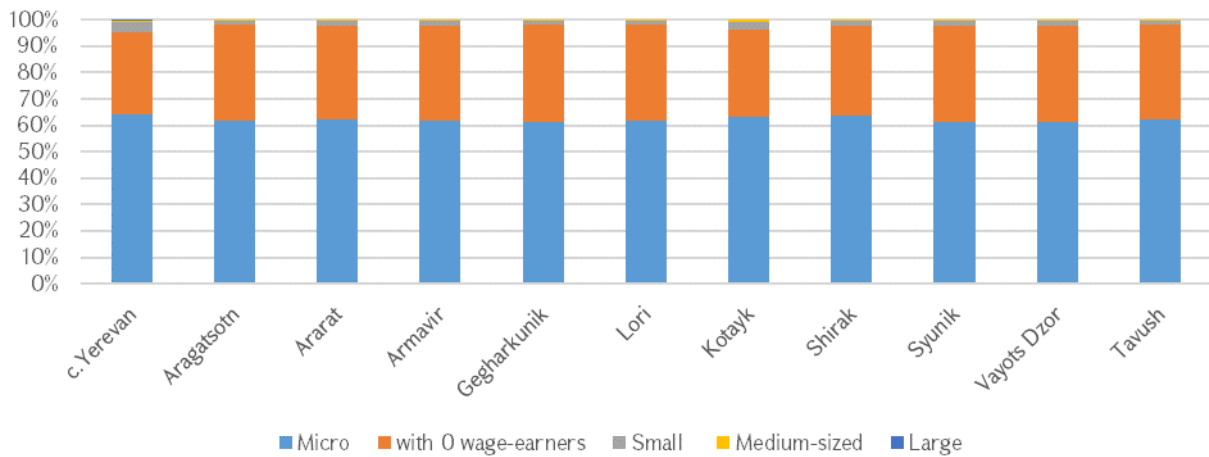


Figure 4. Structure of number of economic entities by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities, 2023

Figure 5. Structure of turnover by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

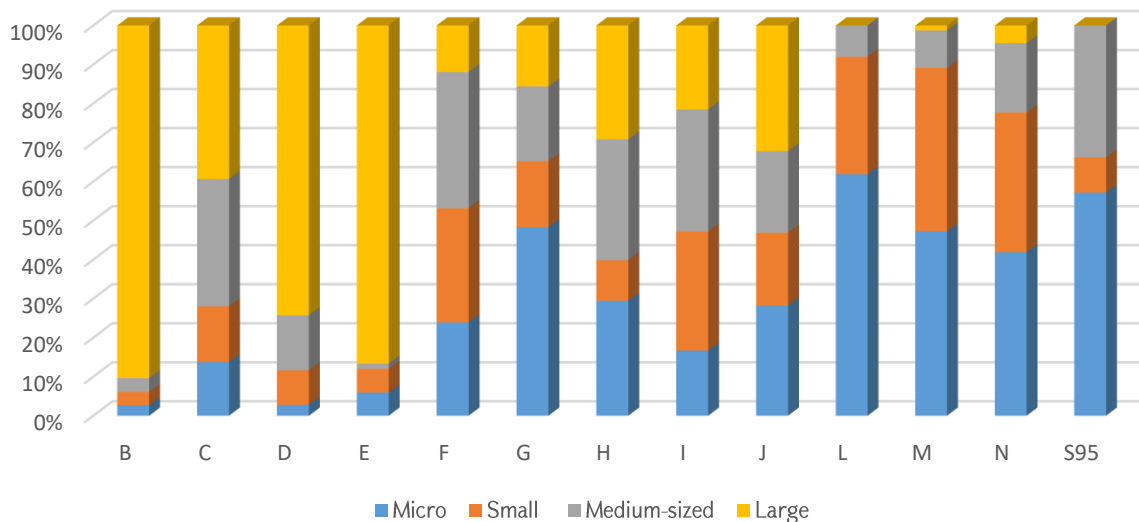


Figure 6. Structure of turnover by NACE Rev.2 sections, 2023

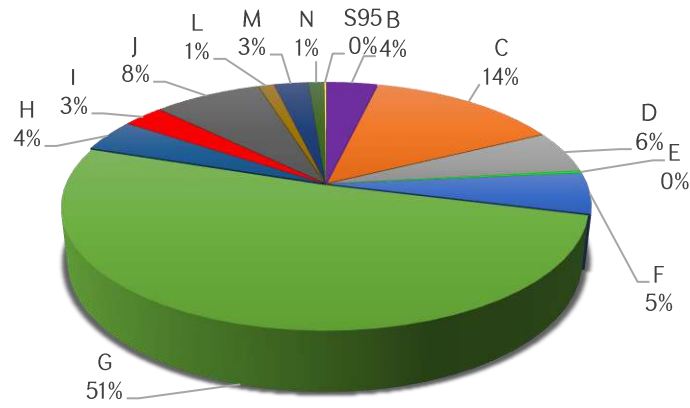


Figure 7. Structure of turnover by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city, 2023

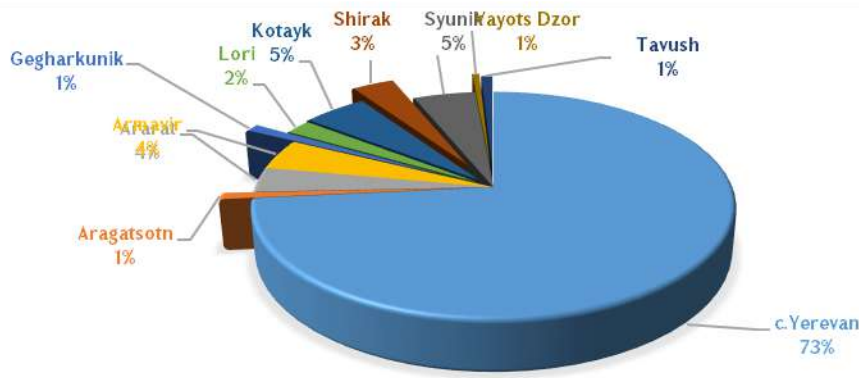
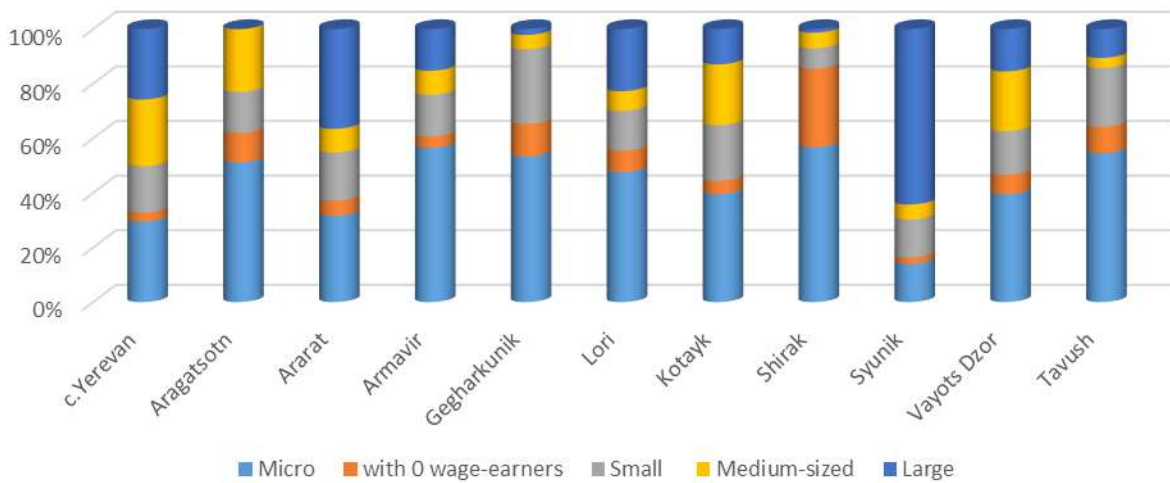


Figure 8. Structure of turnover by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities, 2023

Figure 9. Number of wage-earners by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

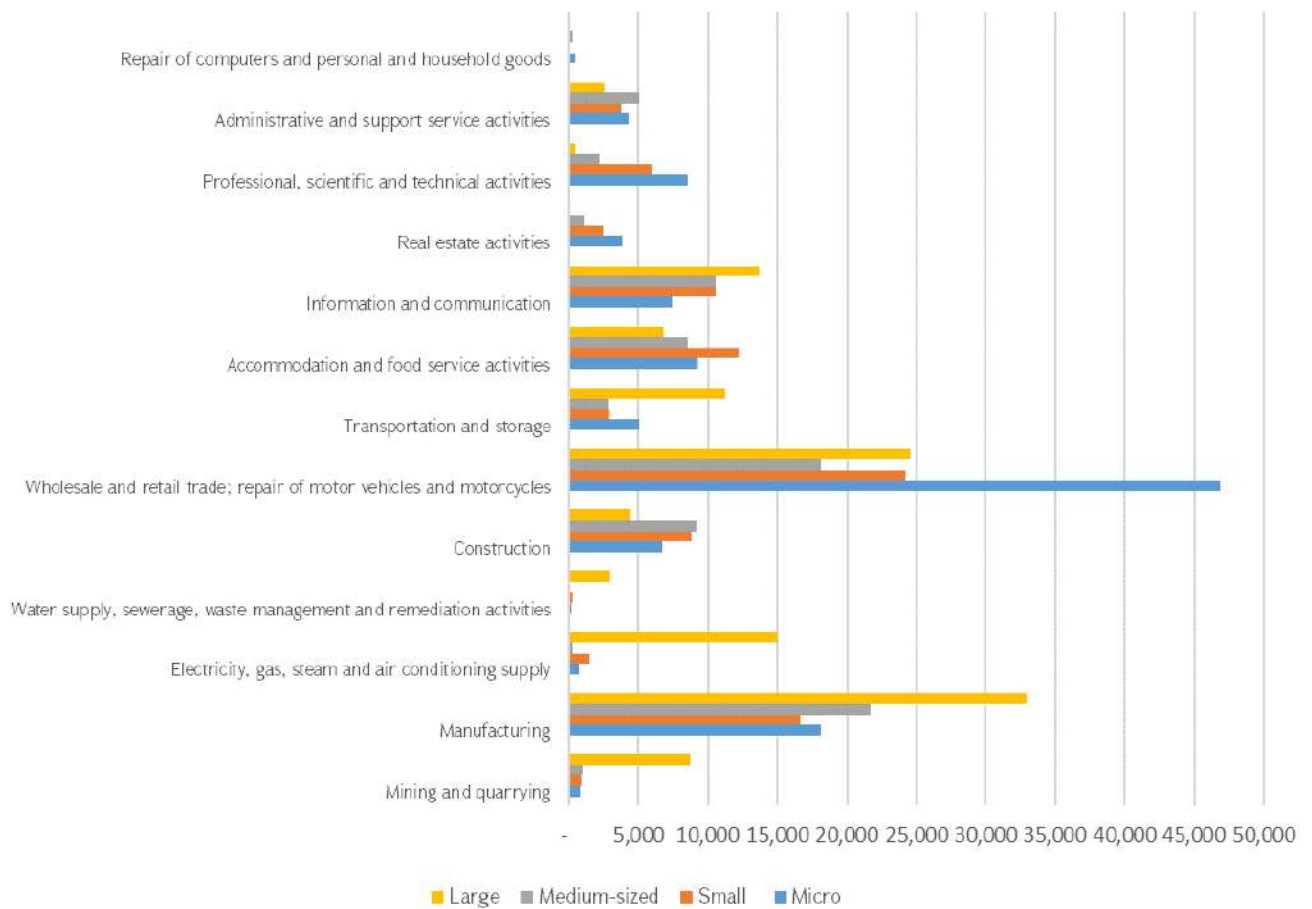


Figure 10. Structure of number of wage-earners by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

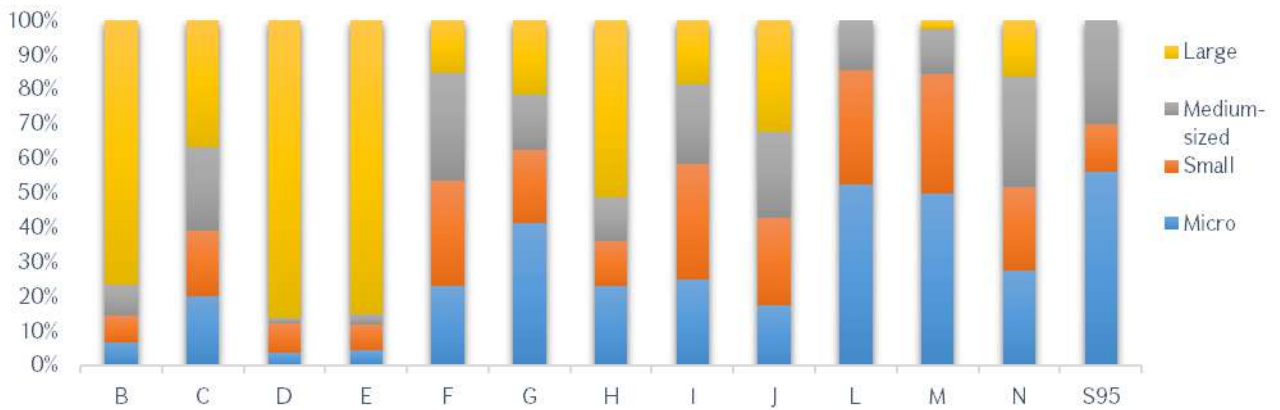


Figure 11. Structure of number of wage-earners by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities, 2023

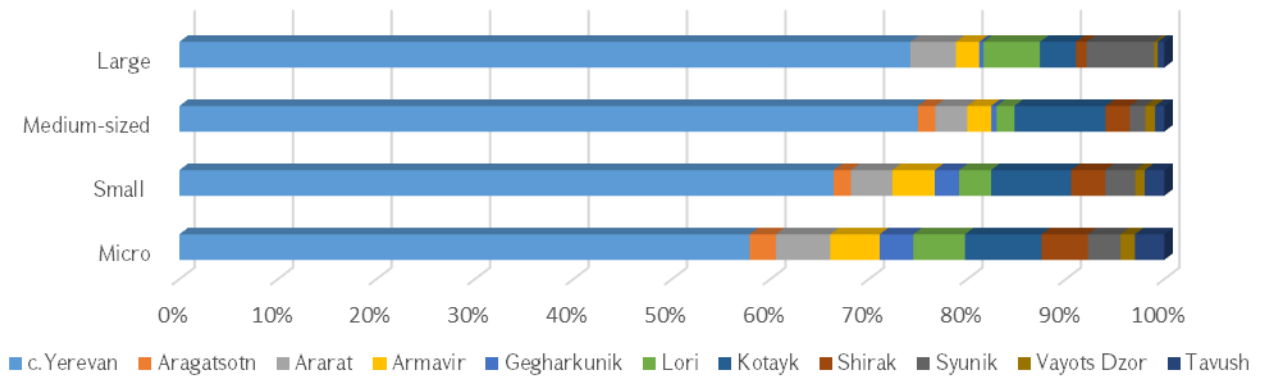
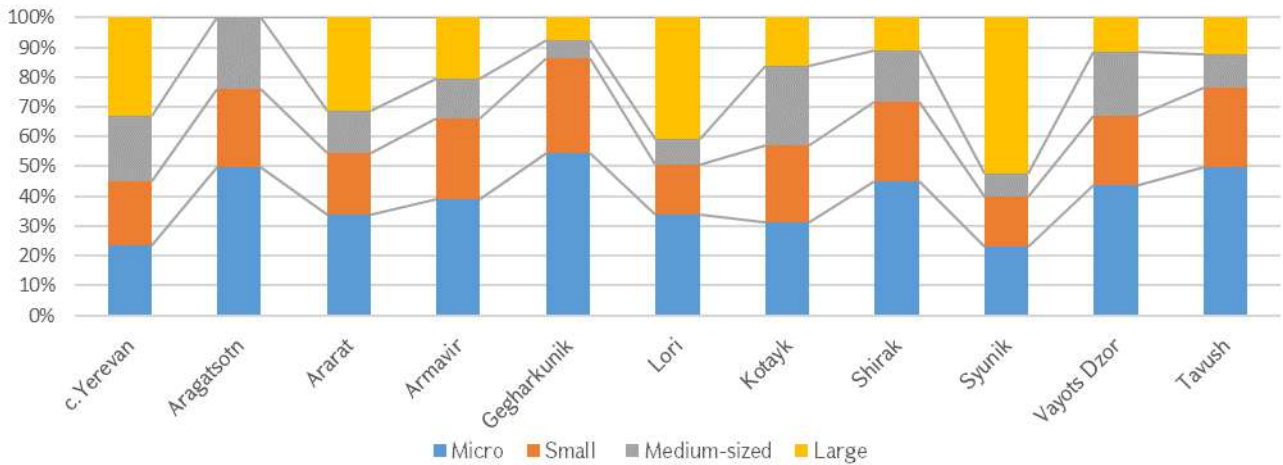


Figure 12. Structure of number of wage-earners by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

Figure 13. Average monthly nominal wages / salaries by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023

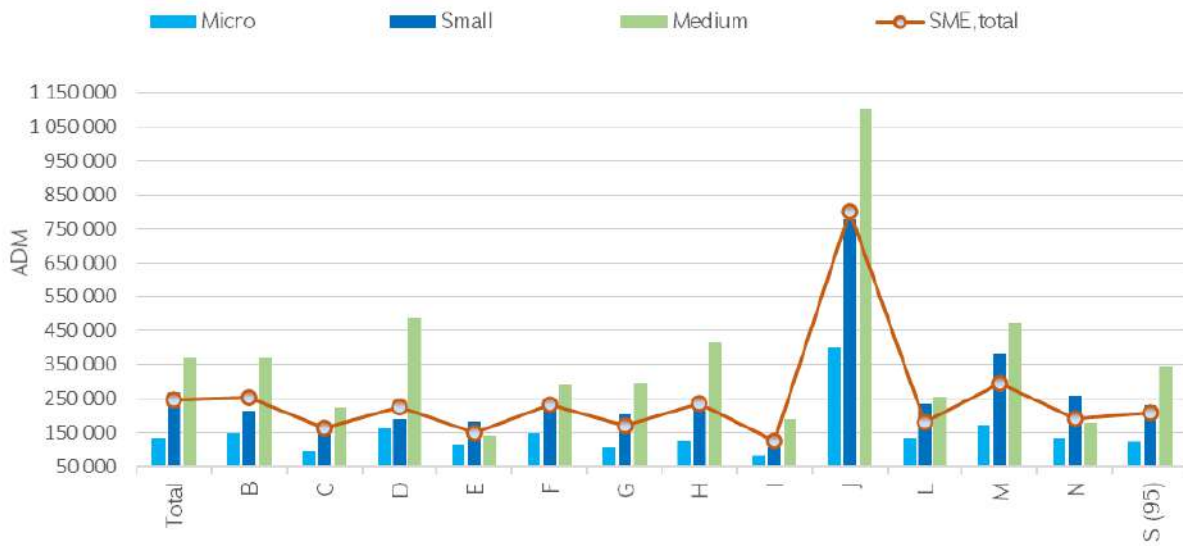


Figure 14. Average monthly nominal wages / salaries by NACE Rev.2 sections and by aggregated size groups of economic entities, 2023

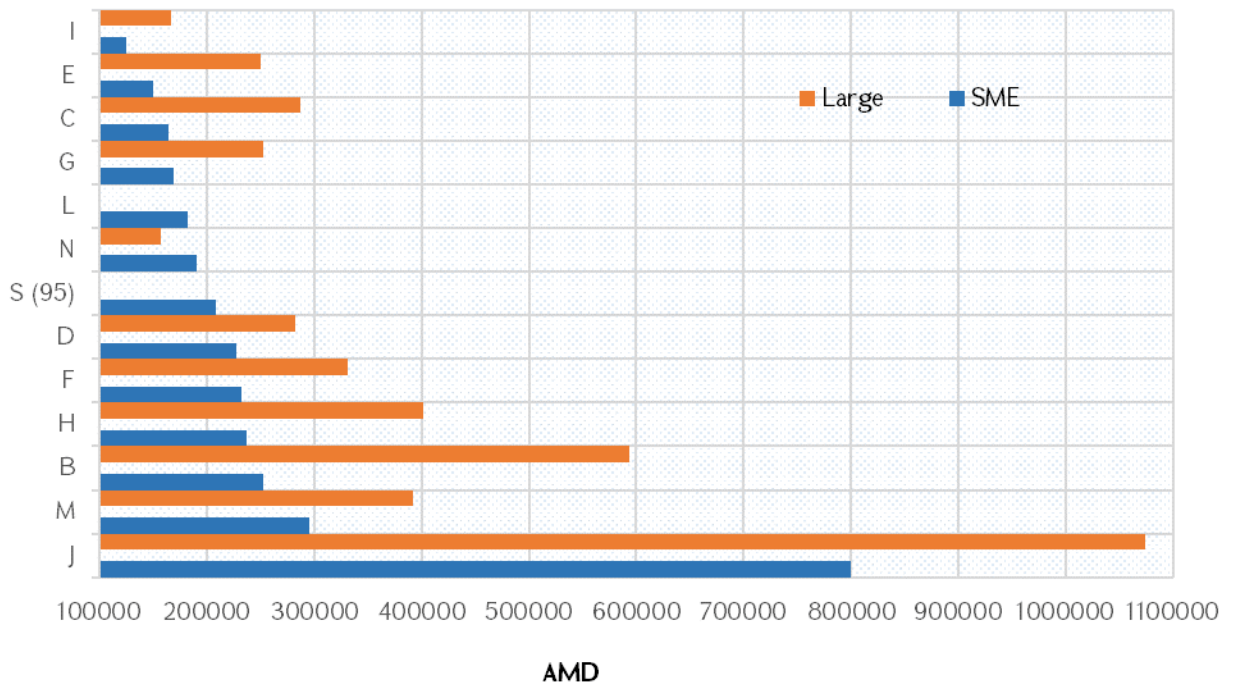
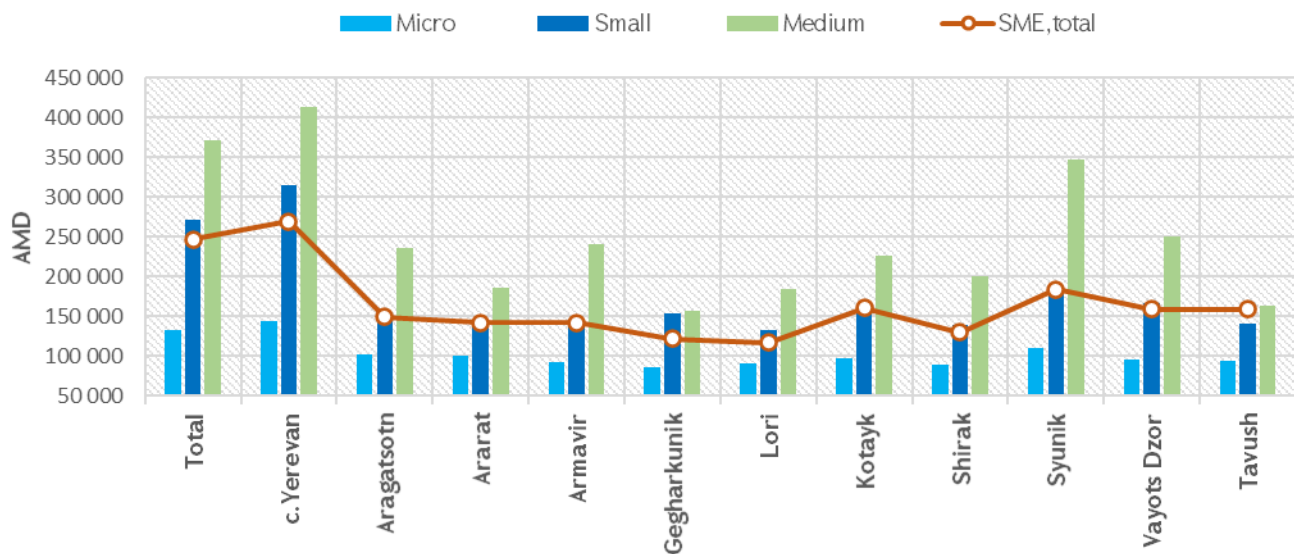

Figure 16. Average monthly nominal wages / salaries by regions (marzes) and Yerevan city and aggregated size groups of economic entities, 2023

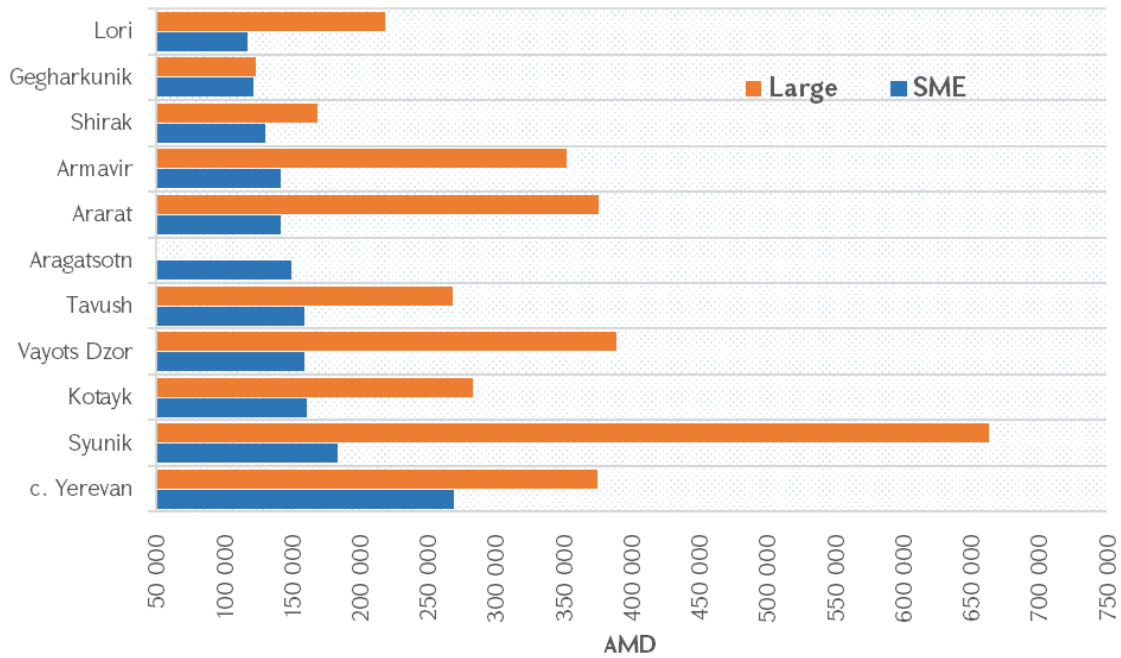
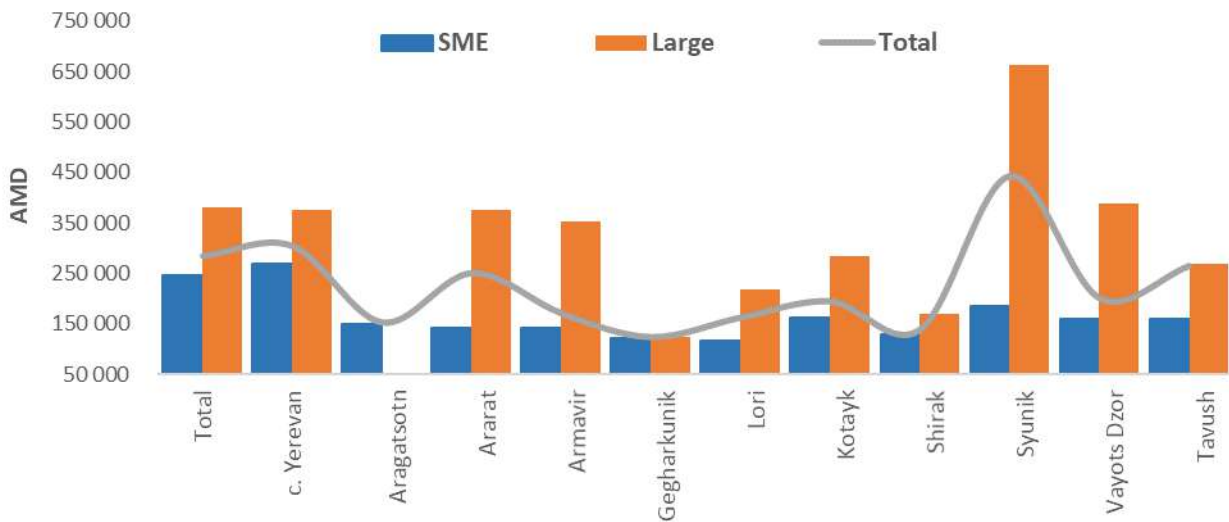


Figure 17. Average monthly nominal wages / salaries by regions (marzes) and Yerevan city and aggregated size groups of economic entities, 2023

Figure 18. Structure of gross value added by size of economic entities, 2023, %

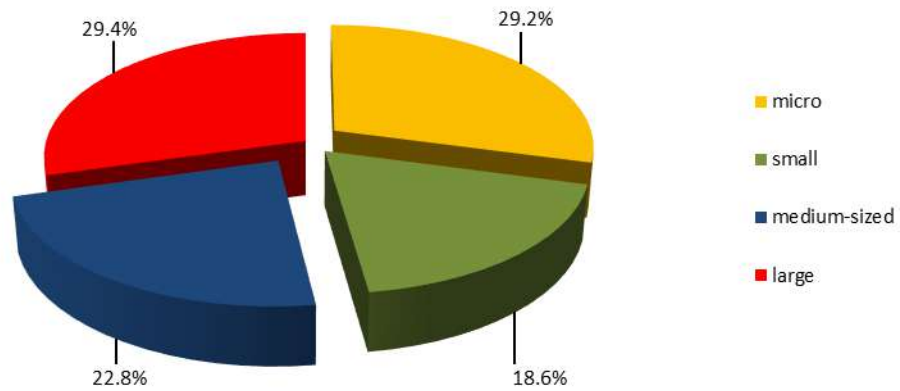


Figure 19. Gross value added by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023, million AMD

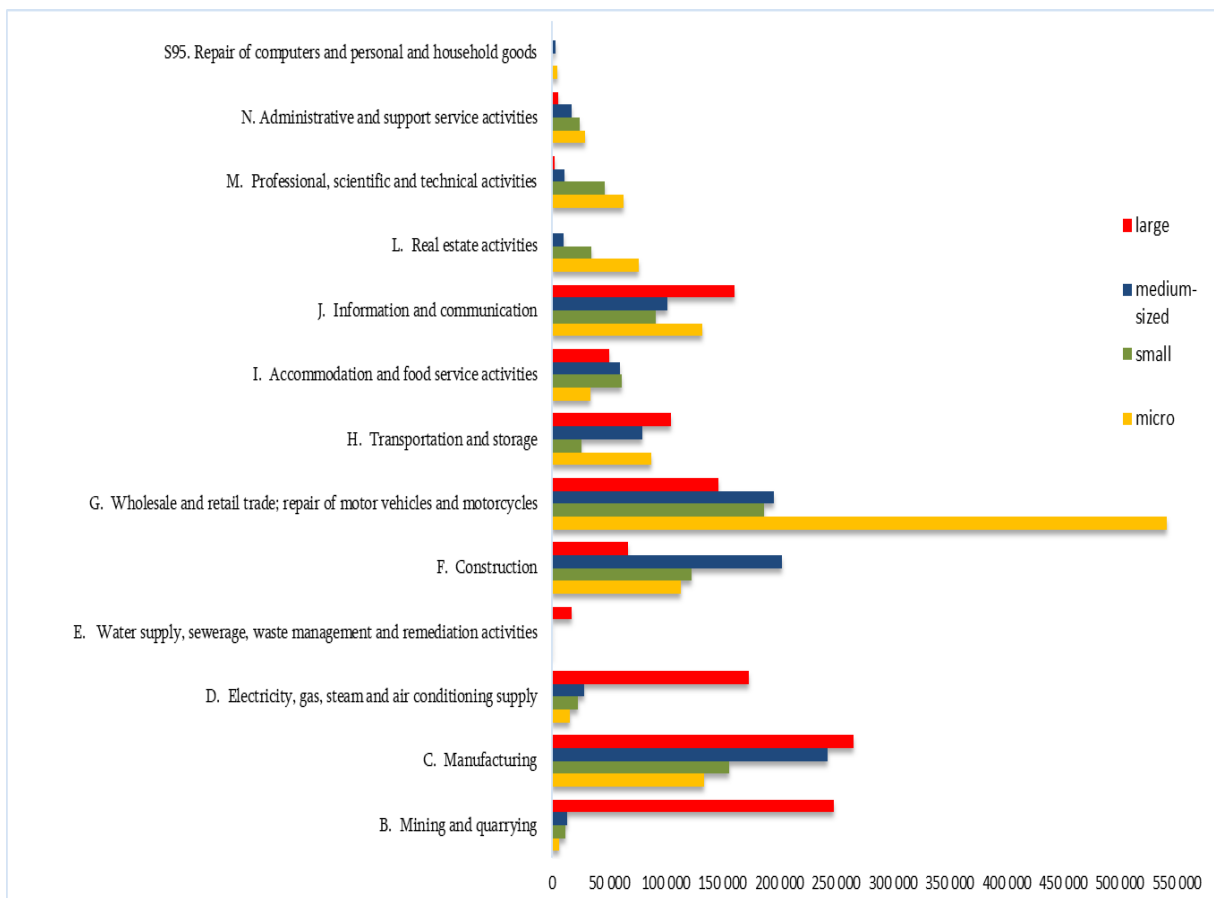


Figure 20. Structure of gross value added by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023, %

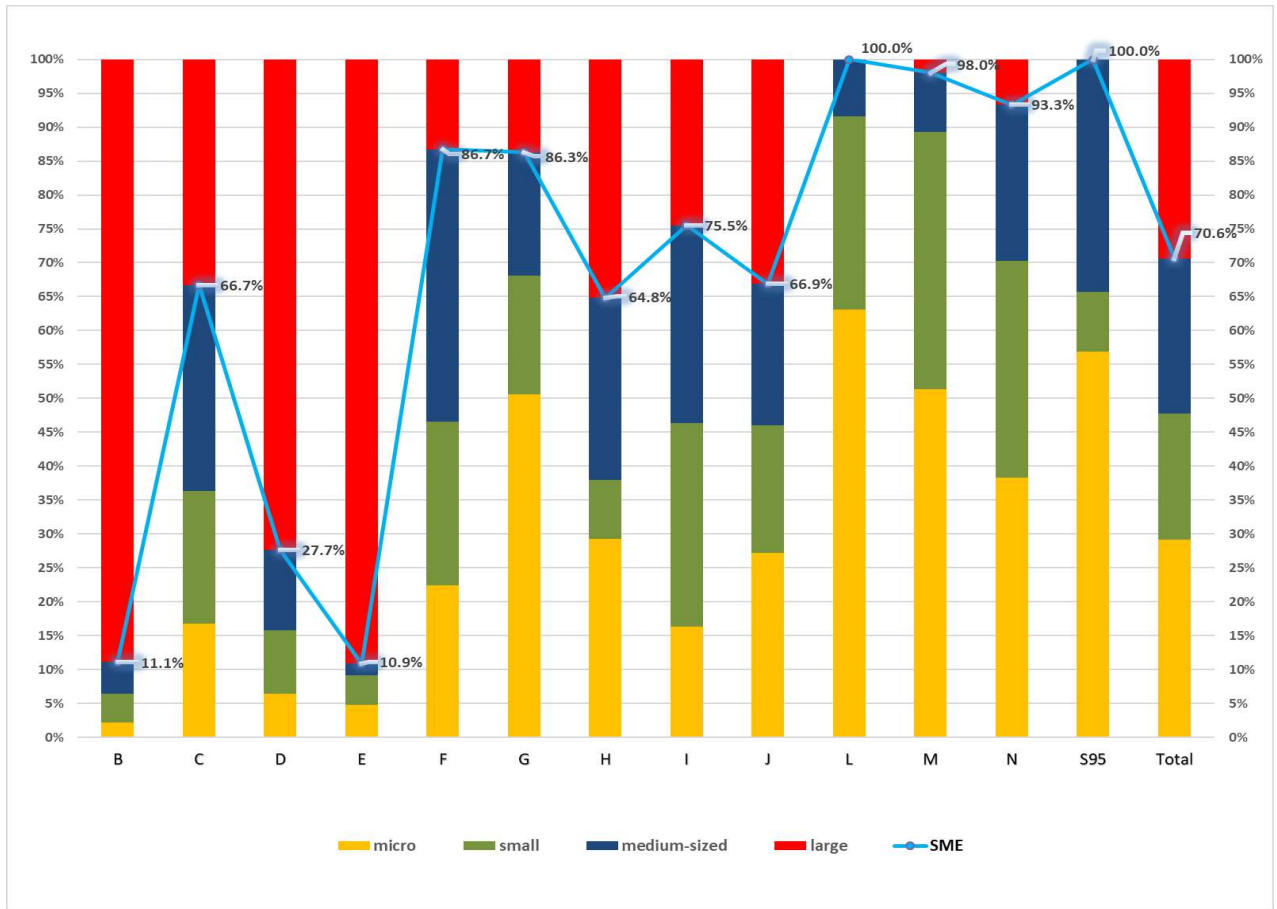

Figure 21. Gross value added by larger groups of NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023, million AMD

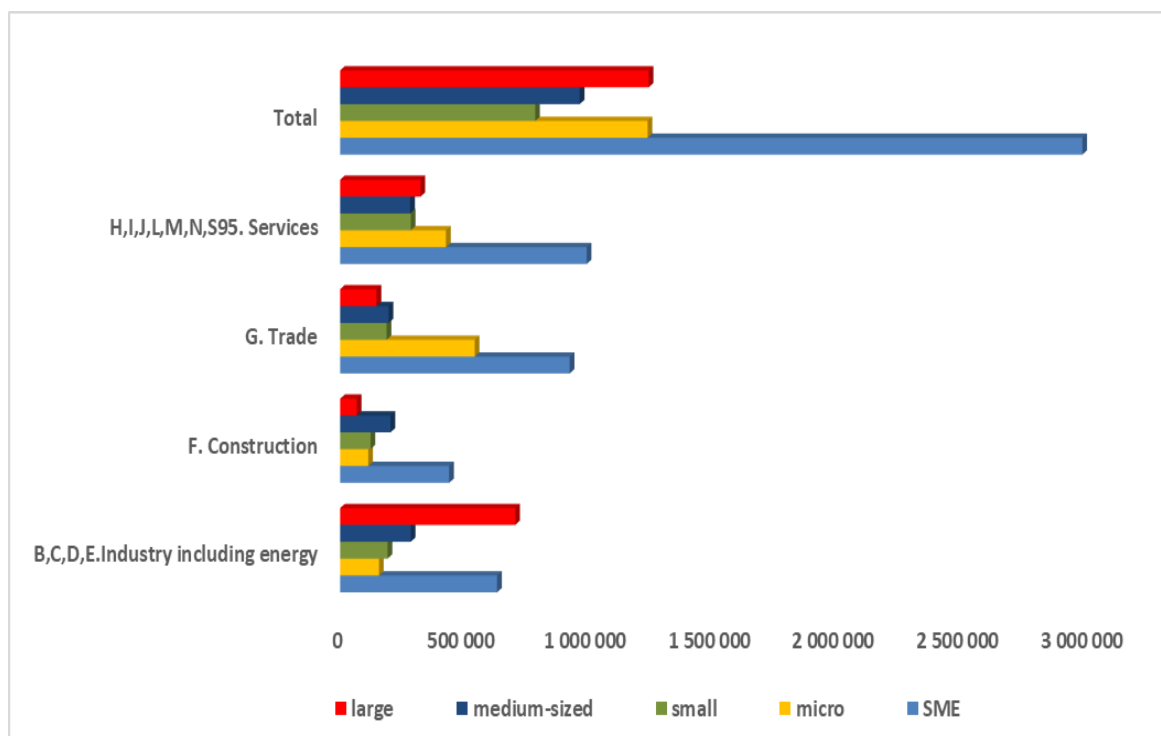

Figure 22. Structure of gross value added by larger groups of NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities, 2023, %

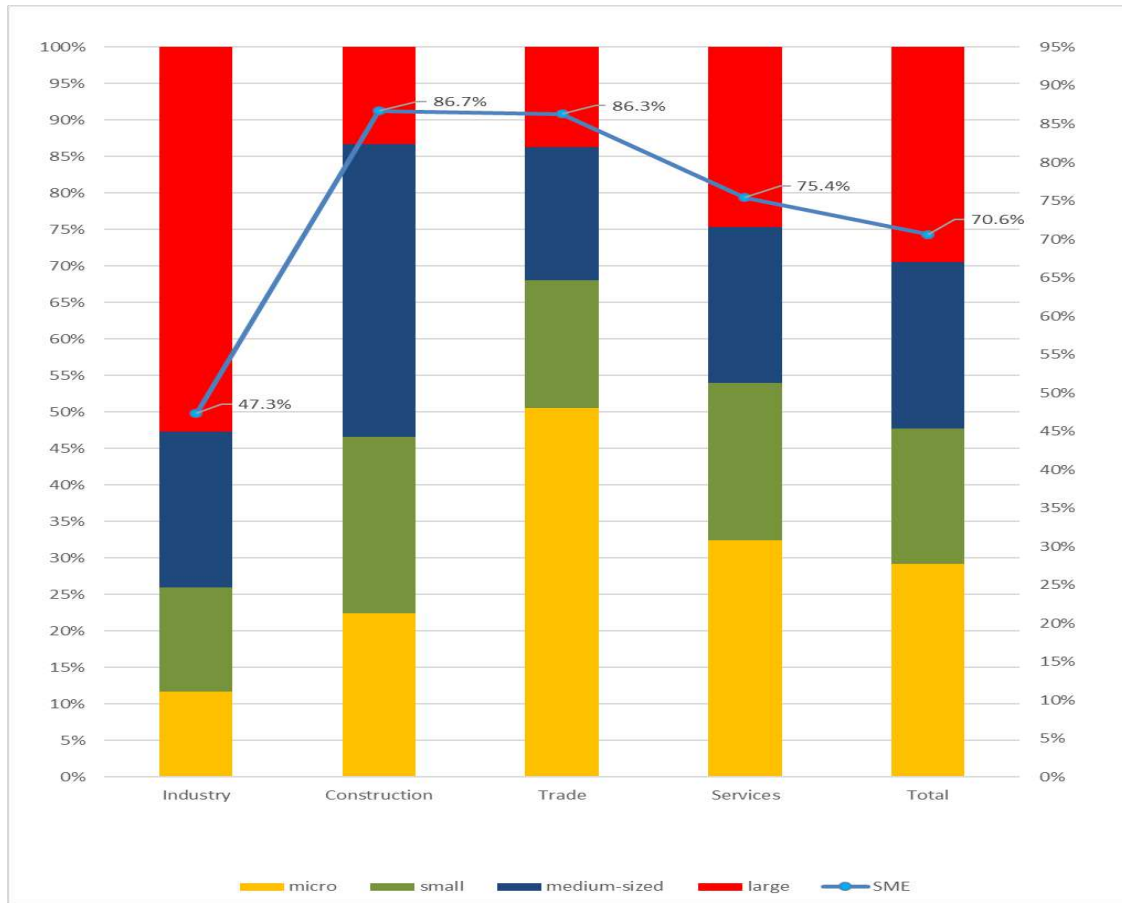

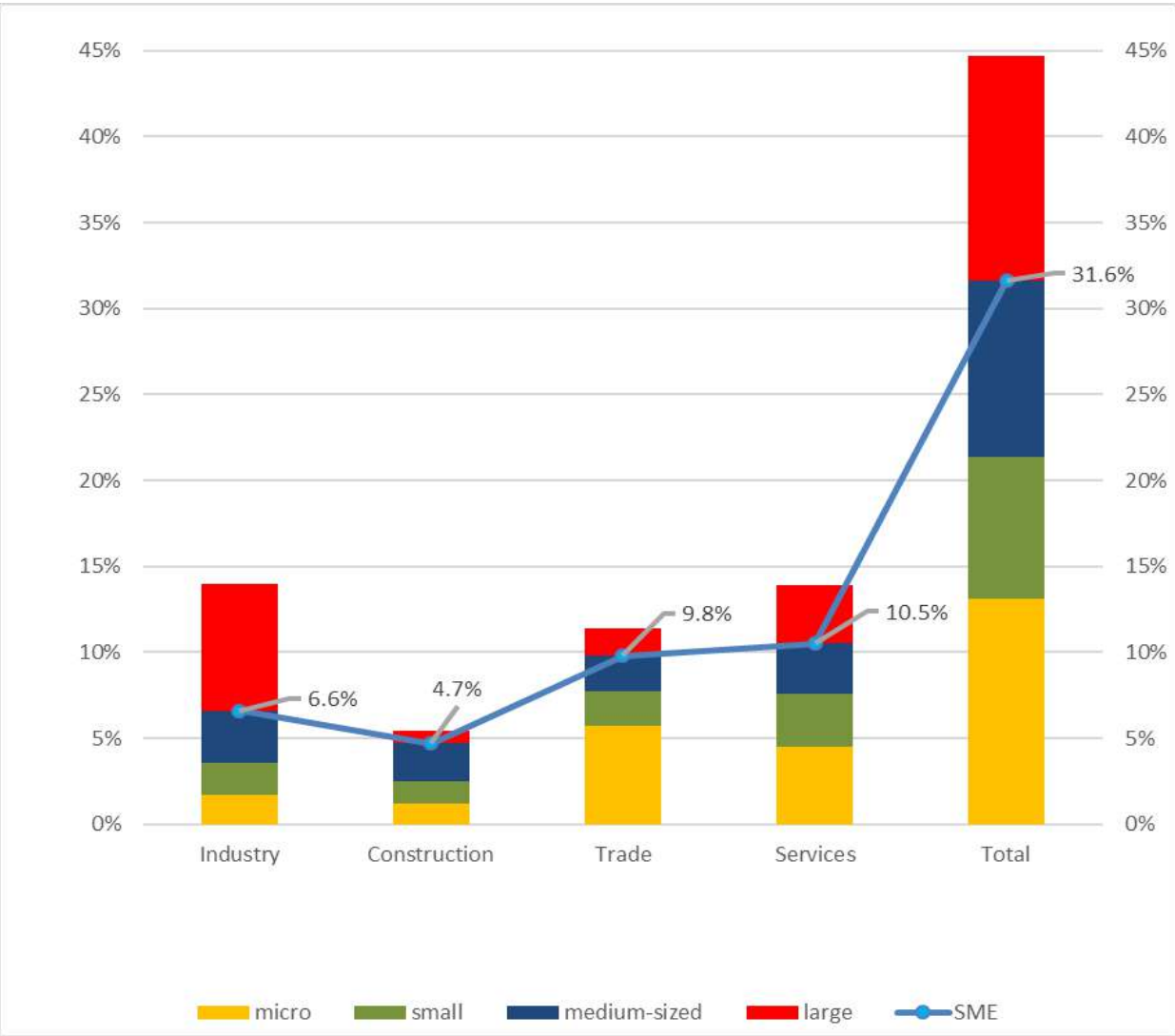

Figure 24. Structure of number of newly established economic entities by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities

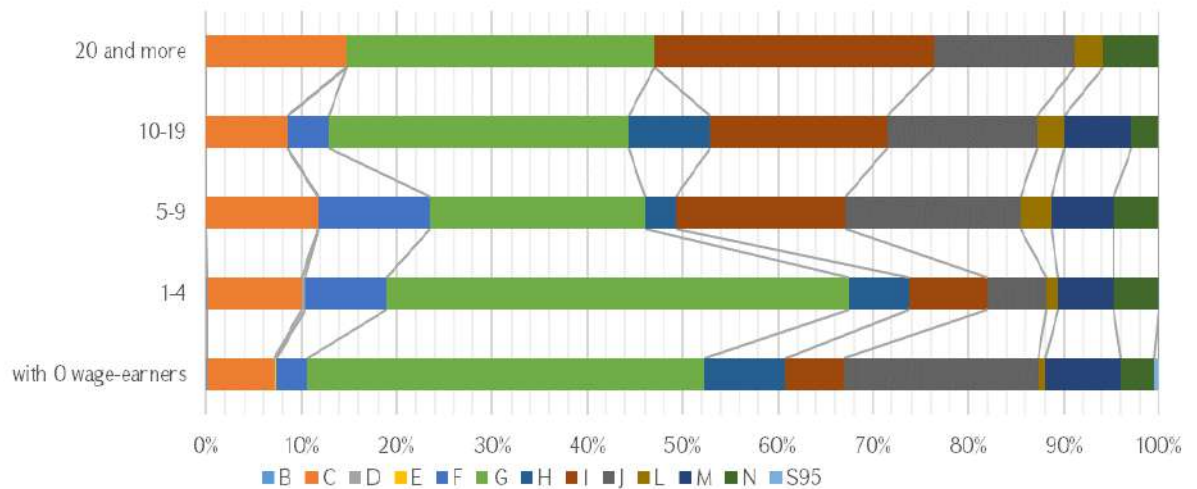

Figure 25. Structure of number of dead economic entities by NACE Rev.2 sections and by size of economic entities

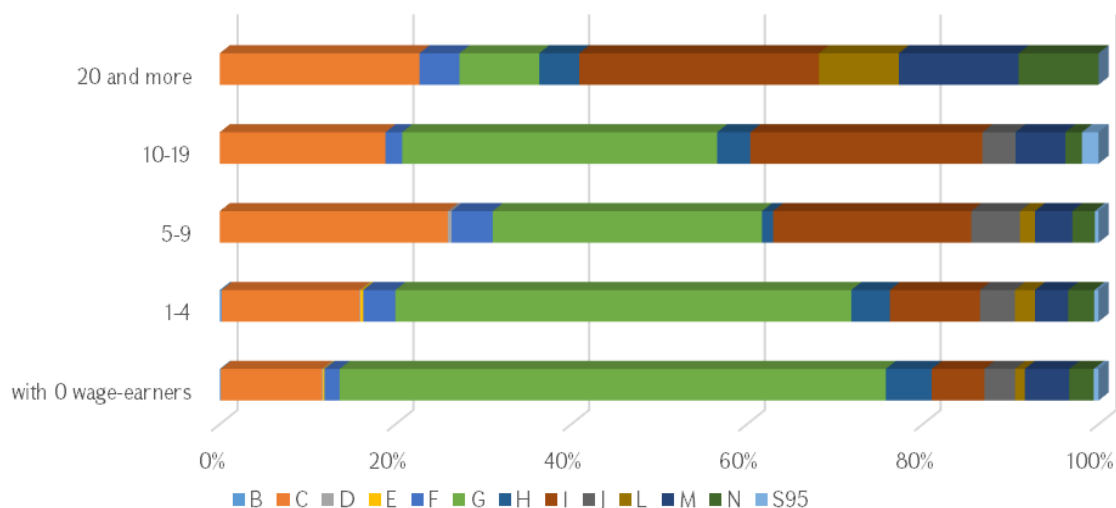


Figure 26. Structure of number of newly established economic entities by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities

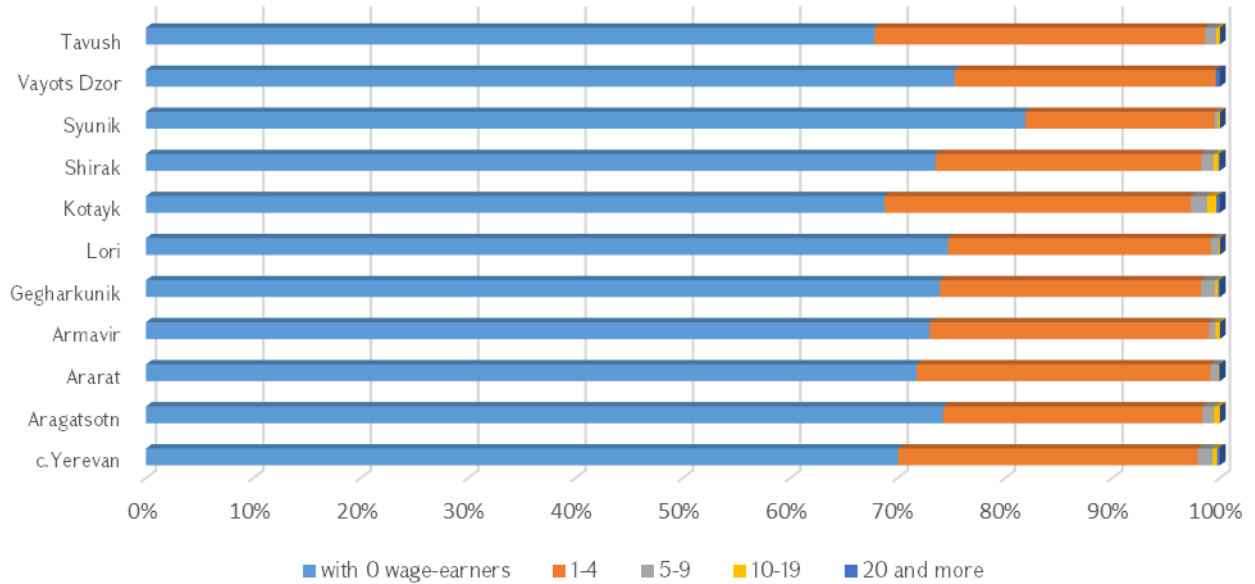


Figure 27. Structure of number of dead economic entities by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities

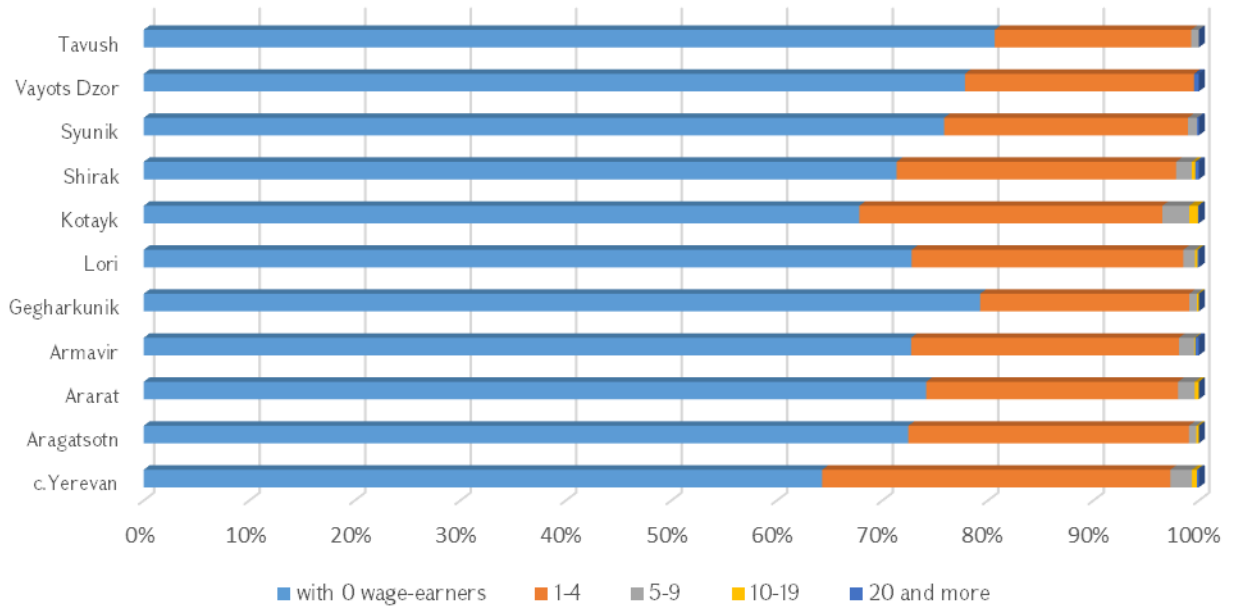

Figure 28. Number of economic entities having survived for 1 year by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities

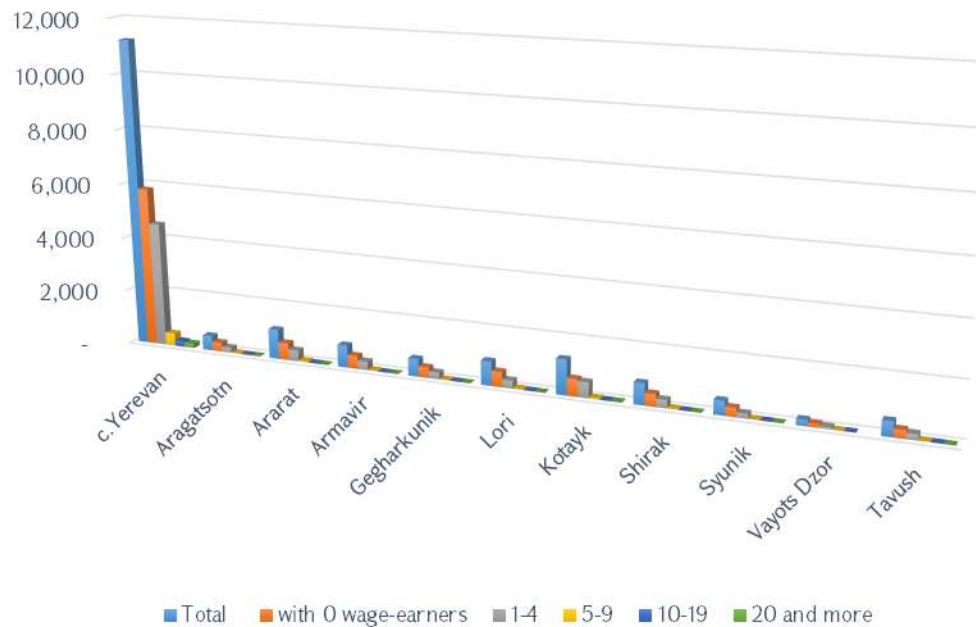

Figure 29. Number of economic entities having survived for 2 years by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city and by size of economic entities

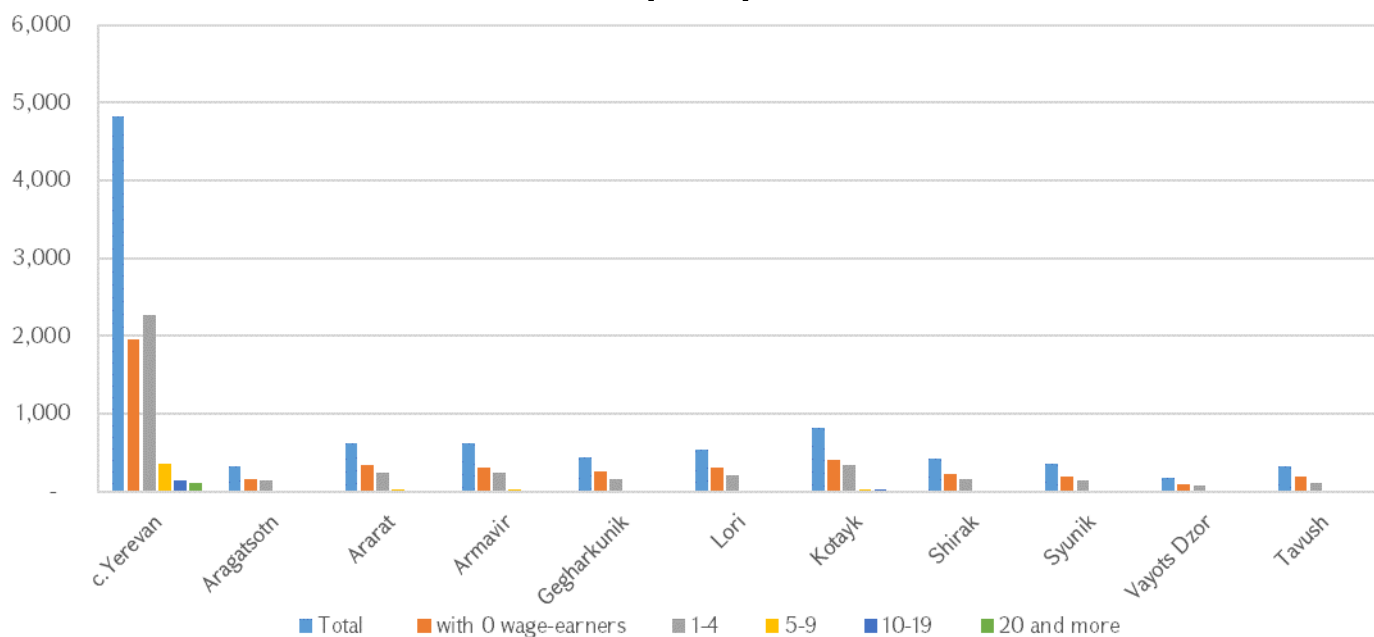

Figure 31. Number of economic entities having survived for one, two or three years by NACE Rev.2 sections

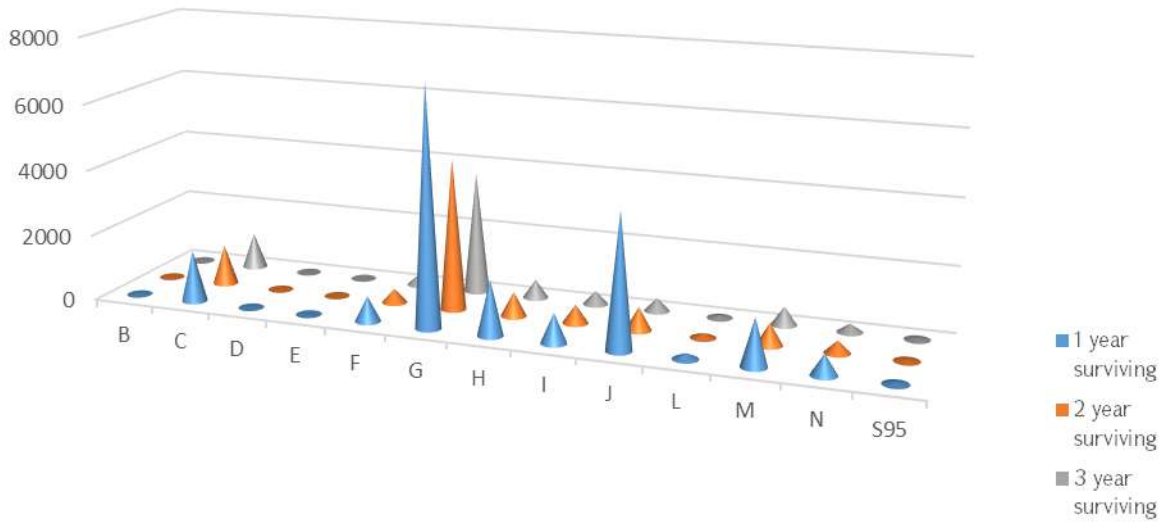


Figure 32. Number of economic entities having survived for one, two or three years by NACE Rev.2 sections

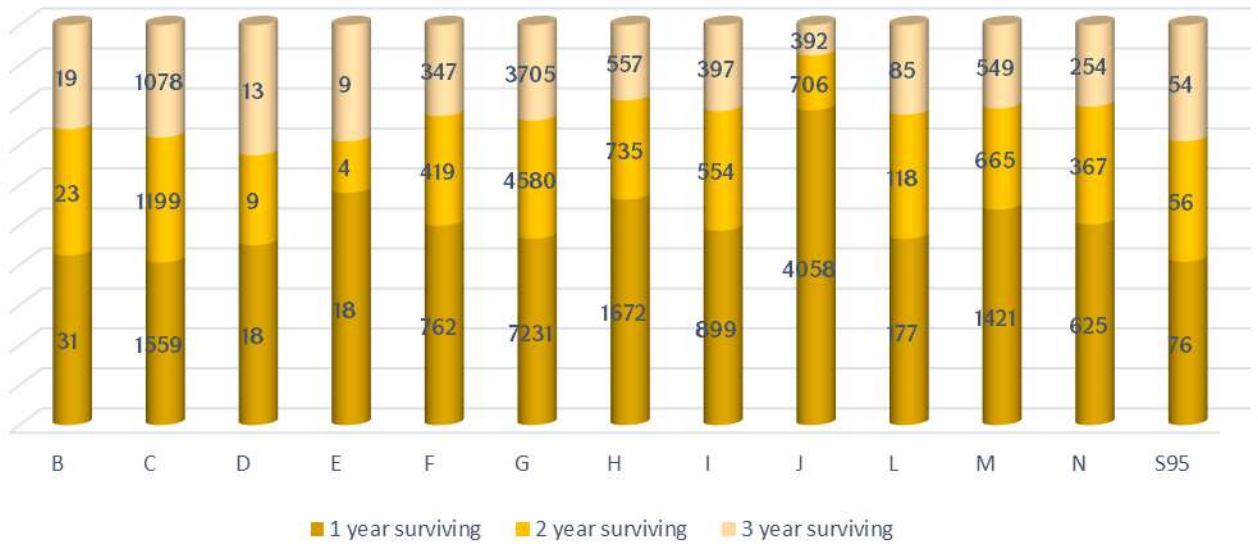


Figure 33. Number of economic entities having survived for one, two or three years by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city

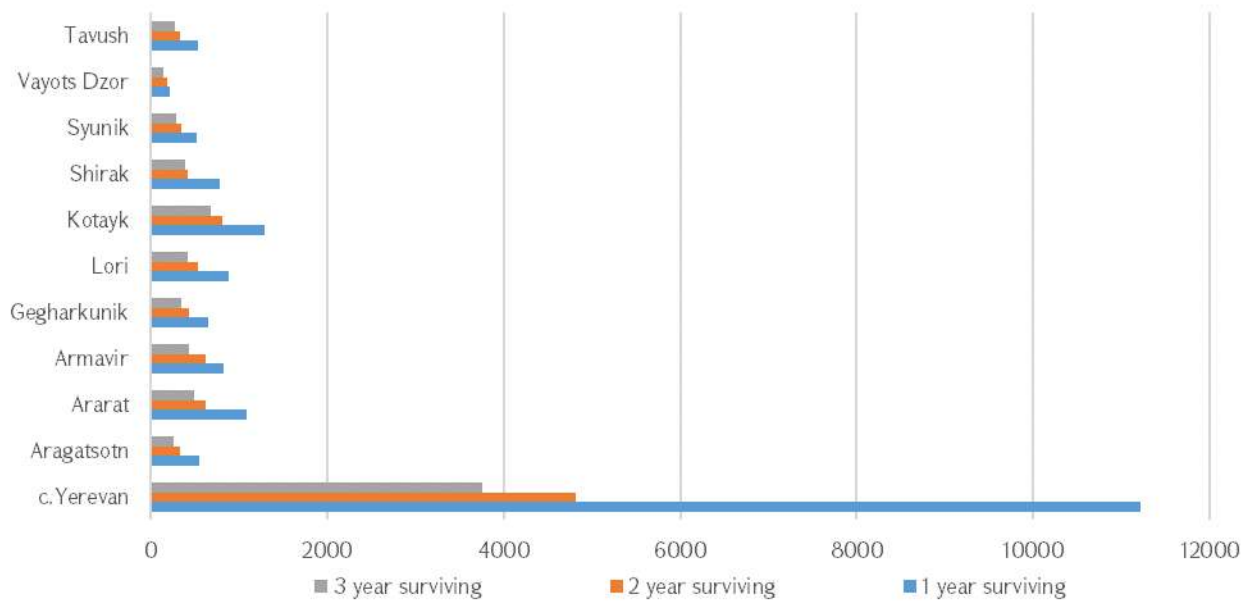
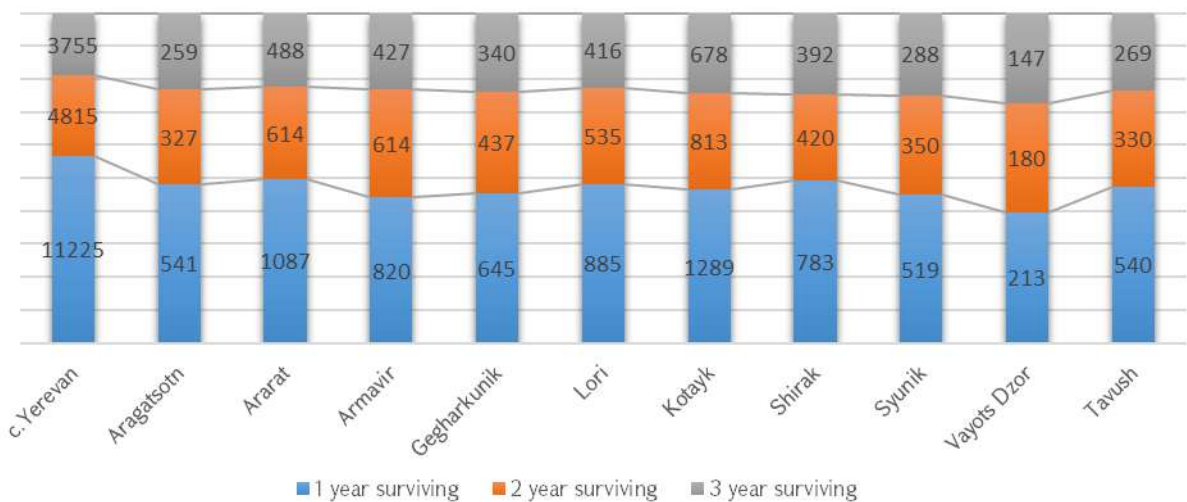


Figure 34. Number of economic entities having survived for one, two or three years by regions (marzes) of the Republic of Armenia and Yerevan city
